Preschoolers are learning the foundational math skills that we utilize on autopilot. Caregivers can share the language of math! Number recognition will allow children to identify things like their phone number. More importantly, understanding quantity will be key in negotiations for cookies during snack time. Recitation of numbers is key when you are marching in your very own second line parade, but connecting those numbers to physical quantities will help cement an important math milestone.

Tips to Connect

Connect the recitation of numbers to number recognition by putting number magnets on the fridge and counting through them one at a time.
